SAFETY TIPS

Alarms

- Confirm that the alarm is functioning and set.
- Check that the alarm company has your contact information.

Security Cameras

- Ensure that cameras are capturing areas of concern.
- If possible, can they be motion activated and accessed remotely?

Lighting

- Keep interior lights on.
- Make sure all exterior lighting is functioning properly.

High Value Items

- Remove items from visibility.
- Remove all cash and receipts. Empty registers and leave them open.
- Remove client or staff personal information that could be stolen and used for identity theft.
- Consider posting "No Cash Kept on Premise" sign
