# To accomplish this, the Advocacy Committee will:

- Educate and inform the business community about relevant county, state and federal policy issues.
- Review county, state and federal legislation and regulations to assess potential impacts on the business community.
- Serve as a resource for information and clearinghouse for the business community and governmental leaders.
- Leverage public policy issues and legislation to promote business growth and support the competitive business environment.
- Recommend positions on certain policy matters pertinent to Envision's mission and vision to the Envision Board of Directors for review and ultimate decision.

## In addition, the Advocacy Committee will *not*:

 Endorse either individual candidates for public office or the platforms of political parties.

#### **Our Legislative Priorities:**

## **Quality of Life**

- Focus on providing first-class customer service to be a business-friendly community, worthy of business investment.
- Investing in daycare systems to provide reliable, affordable and high-quality early childhood education.
- Support affordable housing initiatives such as WHEDA's rural affordable workforce housing initiative.
- Support the enhancement of public safety and security of constituents.

# **Transportation & Infrastructure**

- Support and encourage state and local policy to promote additional broadband expansion by providers across our region.
- Continued improvement of the region's transportation system, the ability to transport people and goods safely and efficiently is vitally important.
- Enhance Fond du Lac County's rail network.

#### **Local Government**

- In order to remain competitive, the responsible use of incentive programs like tax incremental financing will encourage investment and development.
- Support local decision making and protect municipalities from unfunded mandates and preemption of local authority.

#### **Health Care**

- Support the growth of telehealth medicine throughout the County.
- Support initiatives that make employee-sponsored health care more affordable for small businesses.

# **Cultivating Talent Through Higher Education/Public Education**

- Support programs and initiatives that invest in keeping talent in Wisconsin.
- Support the continuation of and growth of the Youth Apprenticeship Program, a known tool for developing careers and retaining youth in our community.
- Continue upskilling our current workforce through partnerships such as MPTC's job trainer program.
- Support the expansion of Registered Apprenticeship program through DWD.
- Prepare high school students for work upon graduation. For those 50% of graduating seniors not pursuing higher education, military or the trades. Provide a collaborative program and resources to match students with existing careers in Fond du Lac County.

# **Business Competitiveness**

- Support the continuation of funding for economic development incentive programs such as WEDC and WHEDA.
- Support local responsibility for property taxation decisions.
- Oppose legislation that impairs the flexibility of local government to utilize all economic development tools currently available.
