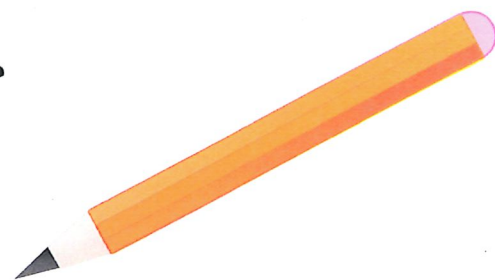

# ANIME & MANGA DRAWING



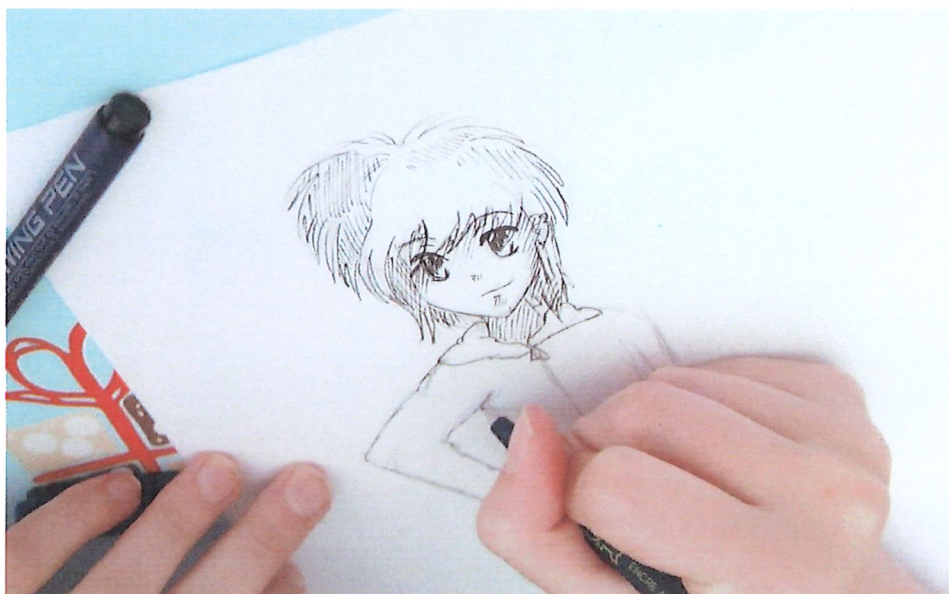
