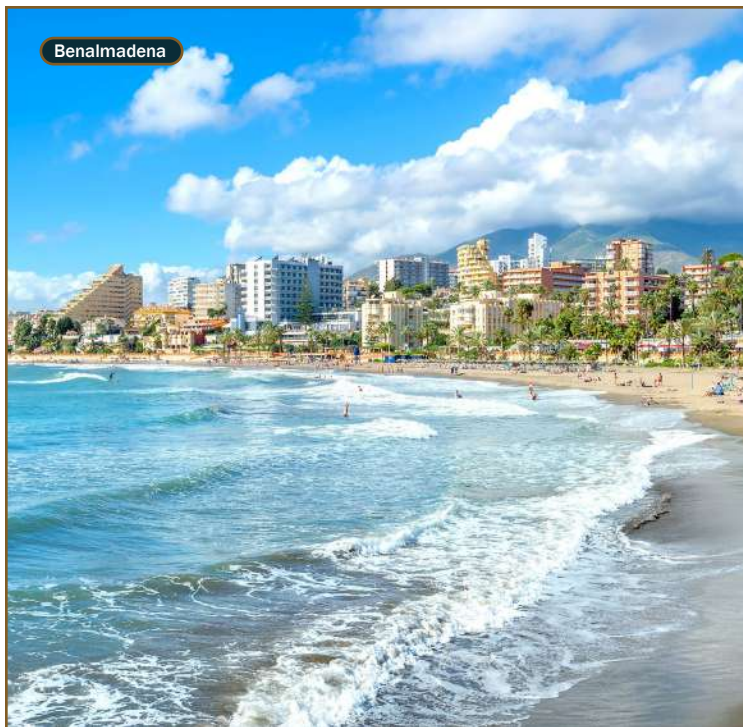

Day 2 Arrive Malaga, Spain - Benalmadena Welcome to the renowned Costa del Sol. With its Mediterranean coastline, the Costa del Sol is one of the most popular destinations in Spain.
